


# Revenue

In 2021, surgery fees covered 60% of the cost of keeping the PetFix clinic's doors open. We raised the remaining funds through donations and foundation grants. Without your assistance, we could not do this important work.

more than 10,000 surgeries in 2021. That's our highest number ever! During the month of June alone, we fixed 939 cats and dogs! Those are amazing numbers. But each animal that is spayed or neutered prevents an average of six unwanted births in the first breeding season alone.

Thank you for making that possible. We are so grateful. You are helping us prevent thousands of pets from struggling to survive on the streets as strays or being needlessly euthanized because there aren't enough homes.

PetFix transports dogs and cats every week from area shelters, spays or neuters them, and returns them that same day. In doing so, we keep animals moving through shelters and into their forever homes, freeing up space for the next animal in need of a second chance. **PetFix also partners** with community organizations, rescues and humane organizations who help us provide care to pet owners in their service area who may not have transportation to the PetFix clinic.
