Revenue

In 2025, surgery fees covered 88% of PetFix's operating costs, with the remainder funded by donations and foundation grants. This work would not be possible without your support.

A Note from PetFix Executive Director

Thanks to the extraordinary generosity of our supporters, PetFix Northeast Ohio successfully completed the \$750,000 *Spay it Forward* Capital Campaign in 2025. This milestone is transforming access to affordable spay and neuter services across Northeast Ohio by enabling us to open a second low-cost spay and neuter clinic.

With more than 140,000 spay and neuter surgeries performed over the past 20 years, PetFix has helped prevent countless pets from entering shelters or struggling to survive without homes. However, demand has continued to far exceed capacity at our Euclid clinic. This campaign—and the expansion of our services—allows us to meet that need head-on.

Because of donor support, interior renovations at our second state-of-the-art spay and neuter clinic in Garfield Heights were completed in February. We are now in the final stages of preparation and anticipate beginning surgeries at the new clinic soon. Once fully operational, this additional capacity will allow PetFix to more than double the number of animals served, dramatically expanding our life-saving impact throughout Cuyahoga County and beyond.

We look forward to welcoming our donors to a celebration and open house in 2026, where supporters will have the opportunity to see firsthand how their investment is creating lasting change for pets, families, and our community.

Together, we are building a future where fewer animals face homelessness—and more pets get the healthy start they deserve.
